REVISIONS TO THE GRADUATE ACADEMIC AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE CHARTER

1. The Graduate Academic and Advisory Committee (GAAC) is a standing committee of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, created in 1968 to advise the Board of Trustees on graduate academic and advisory matters.

2. The GAAC is composed of the following members:

a. The Dean of Graduate Studies, who serves as the chair of the committee.

b. The Vice Dean of Graduate Studies.

3. The GAAC shall have the authority to recommend to the Board of Trustees:

a. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate programs.

b. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate degrees.

c. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate courses.

d. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate faculty.

e. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate student organizations.

f. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate student awards.

g. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate student support services.

h. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate student organizations.

i. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate student awards.

j. The creation, modification, or elimination of graduate student support services.
