“The 1967 Geneva Convention on the Protection of Persons in Armed Conflict, also known as the Geneva Convention Relative to the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War, is an international treaty that aims to protect civilians during armed conflicts. It is one of four Geneva Conventions and is often referred to as the Fourth Geneva Convention. The Convention was adopted by the International Conference of the Red Cross and Red Crescent in Geneva, Switzerland, on August 12, 1949, and entered into force on October 21, 1950. It is now a part of international law and is binding on all states that have ratified it. The Convention applies to situations of armed conflict between states and between regular armed forces and irregular armed groups. It protects civilians from acts of violence, such as torture, and ensures their humane treatment. It also provides for the protection of cultural property and the rights of refugees. The Convention has been amended several times since its original adoption, most recently in 1977 with the Additional Protocols I and II. It is considered a cornerstone of international humanitarian law and is widely regarded as an essential tool for protecting civilians in times of war.”
